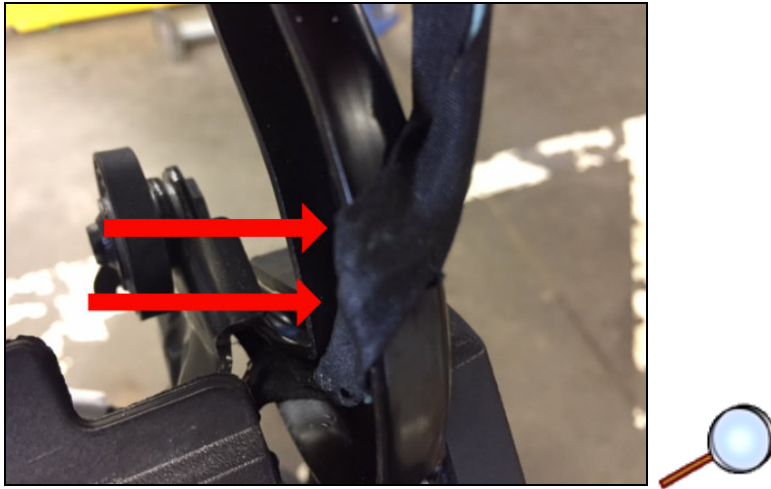

Harness chaffing at the hinge area of the center console.

Correction

Inspect the center console harness at any part of the hinge area for chaffing. See example below.



If any harness damage is found, repair as necessary.
