During my 45 years of government and private sector experience, I have performed engineering, design and construction management of all project types, supervised construction offices throughout the mid-Atlantic region, California, Washington and Utah and supervised technical teams numbering up to 60 personnel. I have a proven track record of civil and structural engineering, construction management, contract management, dispute resolution, and expert witness on projects ranging from small renovations to hospitals, dams and other major infrastructure. I have designed, built and remodeled many personal properties.

2013-present: **Consulting Engineer**, I am retired from full time federal service and perform professional engineering consulting and construction management on a part time basis.
