Dear Chief Executive

Not only the Council, but also the Local Government Ombudsman have been asking endlessly for medical reports to support my claim that the last assessment is incomplete. It appears that you forgot, so conveniently, to tell the Ombudsman why I am reluctant to let you have any of my reports....It is not necessary to embarrass you again, the reasons for my reluctance have been documented elsewhere.

To satisfy these cries, I now submit one of my latest specialist neurological reports. It is rendered anonymous in line with General Medical Council's guidelines relating to handling of confidential personal medical information without altering its veracity.

As you are an ex Social Worker yourself, like all those at the Council who are hankering after these reports, you should understand it, able to tell the difference between demyelination, amaurosis fugax and constipation. Otherwise it would be a brazen, absurd waste of time, would it not?

To prove me wrong, I should be grateful for your interpretation of this, relatively simple report, together with a statement how it affects my claim, if at all, and most importantly, **why**.
